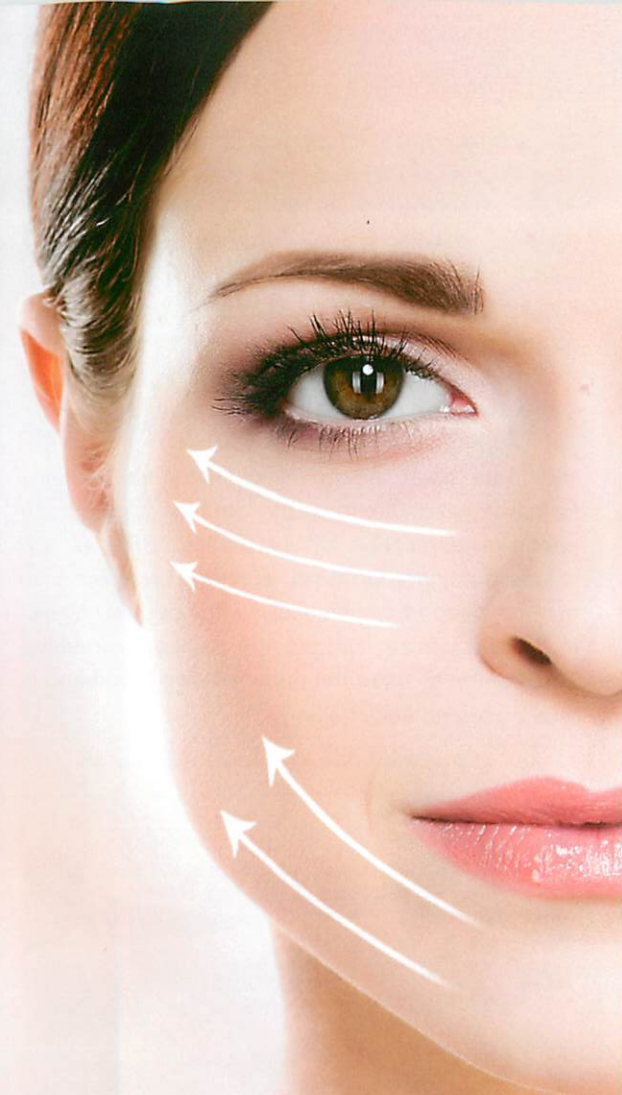

Platelet Rich Plasma (PRP) Treatment

Our dental office offers the latest in Platelet Rich Plasma (PRP) and micro-needling rejuvenation treatments. PRP, Platelet-Rich-Plasma, is what we call "your body's liquid gold." Your body's PRP has more than 8 essential growth factors which are anti-aging, collagen stimulating and recovery boosting agents that when released and activated properly will leave your skin glowing.

PRP has been around in dentistry for healing for many years, and over the last few years it has grown in popularity for aesthetics. PRP is a valuable adjunct for facial rejuvenation which may be used in combination with dermal fillers to help volumize and provide immediate results. The treatment uses the patient's own blood and thus poses no risk of allergy.



What Is Platelet Rich Plasma?

Platelet-Rich Plasma, or PRP, is obtained by drawing a small amount of blood from your arm into a sterile tube. This sample is centrifuged to separate your plasma, which we use for the treatment, from your red and white blood cells. Plasma contains a high concentration of platelets, stem cells and growth factors which help your tissue heal and grow new cells. PRP benefits patients at any age, but is most effective as an anti-aging regimen.



The Benefits of Micro-Needling Platelet Rich Plasma Treatment:

- ❖ Reduce fine lines and wrinkles
- ❖ Eliminate dark spots and discoloration
- ❖ Stimulate hair growth
- ❖ Tighten and tone loose or saggy skin
- ❖ Replace mild collagen and volume loss
- ❖ Treat crow's feet and dark under eye circles
- ❖ Even out acne scarring
- ❖ Lighten rosacea

How Does Micro-Needling Work?

The treatment introduces fine needles to the skin to create microscopic channels. In doing so the dermis is encouraged to produce new collagen and elastin which generates new skin cells. The skin then becomes more vibrant, plumper and more youthful. Serums that are applied to the skin afterwards are also up to 1000 times more effective, as the skin is able to absorb more of the product.

With or without PRP application, micro-needling is ideal for treating stretch marks, fine lines and wrinkles, pigmentation problems, acne scars and burn scars.

What to Expect Before, During and After your PRP Treatment?

You will arrive 30 minutes prior to your scheduled appointment time for application of a topical numbing cream to the area that will be treated. At that time, a small amount of your blood will be drawn and put into a centrifuge to separate the plasma from other components of your blood. The plasma, PRP, will then be penetrated into the skin via injections and/or smearing post your micro-needling treatment.

Avoid direct exposure to the sun after your treatment for 7 days and be sure to wear sun block when going out. You want to ensure your maximum results by following your provider's after-care instructions.

We recommend a series of at least three treatments about four to six weeks apart to see the best results. You can then do the treatment about once a year to maintain. The number of treatments will vary from patient to patient, typically ranging from 4-8 sessions.
